Pariso Scholarship in Communication Studies

This essay competition scholarship for Undergraduate students was established in 2006 through the benevolence of Mr. Stephen Pariso, BA 2004, and Ms. Shauna Vineberg-Pariso.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must be enrolled in the Communication Studies program, in their second year of studies (or higher).
- Applicants must be studying full-time during the Fall 2022 and Winter 2023 terms.
- Applicants must have a GPA of at least 3.30
- Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents and International Students are eligible

Award Value: One award available valued at \$1,250 - Non-renewable.

How to Apply:

Qualified candidates who wish to apply for this award must submit, along with their application form:

- A 750-word essay, in response to the following questions:
 - o How is your background different from that of a majority of students in Communication Studies?
 - o How have your past life experiences added to your classroom experience?
 - o What unique factors do you bring to Communication Studies as a student?
 - o How do your life experiences provide a unique or different perspective to your studies?
 - o How do these experiences help add diversity to the classroom experience?

Essays must address all of the above questions in a scholarly fashion. **Essay submissions must include an application form, and a cover sheet bearing the title, "Pariso Scholarship Essay Competition."** If you have a Co-Curricular Record at Concordia University, feel free to include a copy with your submission along with the other supporting documents described above.
