Eligibility Criteria

Status: Full-time enrollment Fall 2018 and Winter 2019

GPA: Assessment GPA of **2.70 or higher**

Citizenship: Open to Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, and International Students

Applicant's Essay

Qualified students who wish to be considered for this award must, in addition to their application form, submit a 500-word essay which details their involvement in student life activities, and participation in student associations, within the Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science. If you have a **Co-Curricular Record** at Concordia University, feel free to include a copy with your submission in addition to your essay.

Essays will be judged on content, as well as the quality of the applicant's reasoning and written expression of ideas.
