

Undergraduate Award Bulletin Garnet Key Entrance Award

The Garnet Key Entrance Award is intended to encourage and reward students pursuing an undergraduate degree program at the University, whose commitment and spirit towards community involvement and academic excellence reflect the values exemplified by Garnet Key Society. In addition to this, the purpose of the endowment is to raise awareness of the Garnet Key Society to students with the hopes that it will create further interest and garner greater competition for students entering into the Garnet Key Society. This award is in perpetuity.

Eligibility Criteria

Program: New students enrolled in any program leading to a Bachelor's degree.

Status: Full-time enrollment Fall 2021 and Winter 2022

GPA: Assessment GPA of 3.00 or higher

Citizenship: Open to Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, and International Students

Award Value: \$500

Applicant's Essay

Qualified students who wish to be considered for this award must, in addition to their application form, submit a letter of intent in which they will have to demonstrate their civic engagement or community project.

Essays will be judged on content, as well as the quality of the applicant's reasoning and written expression of ideas. If you have a **Co-Curricular Record** at Concordia University, feel free to include a copy with your submission along with the other supporting documents described above.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: October 15, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.
