#### SHORT DESCRIPTION

Under the supervision of the Executive Director, carry out tasks related to Black history in Quebec; in the context of student placement, priority given to an Afro-descendant.

- Research and write texts
- Data collection, related clerical tasks for external communications: social media and newsletters
- Participation in the content and logistics of events: exhibit, Canada Day and Emancipation Day.

### **REQUIREMENTS**

- Only enrolled Concordia students in an undergraduate program are eligible for this position.
- \* Desired competency: understanding communication issues in 2025.
- \* Preparation of reports on research and writings found and archived.
- Responsible, adaptable, autonomous, rigorous, resourceful, conscientious.
- \* Bilingualism (French and English) required for this position
- \* Ease of communication Ability to analyze, learn quickly and meet deadlines.

The candidate will "travel" mainly in the Montreal area.

### DURATION and SITE OF EMPLOYMENT

Hours: 200 hours (20 hours/week)

Start: June 2, 2025 End: August 8, 2025

Position will be hybrid through a combination of in-person and remote hours. Some expected
