Criteria

 The candidate must be a member of the current Spring graduating class or a member of the Fall graduating class immediately preceding it.

- 2. The candidate is usually expected to have a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 at the time of graduation to be eligible (a minimum of 60 credits must be from Concordia).
- 3. The candidate should have demonstrated the quality of leadership.
- 4. The candidate should have won the outstanding commendation of his/her fellows and of the Faculty.
- The candidate must have achieved distinction in at least two of the following areas:

 Student government • Extra-curricular activities • Athletic activities • Creative achievement • Outstanding contribution to the University • Outstanding academic record

Submission Procedures

- a) Nominations should be signed by three members of the University community, preferably members from different sectors. At least one nominator must be a Concordia faculty or staff member.
- b) The nominee must agree to have their name put forward.
- c) The award will be adjudicated by the Special Graduation Awards Committee of Senate.
- d) The nomination deadline is April 7. <u>See website for</u> submission details.

Failure to submit the following $\underline{required}^*$ documents will result in an automatic disqualification of the nomination:

Each nominator must submit a personal, signed <u>letter of</u> <u>recommendation</u>* that clearly demonstrates how the candidate meets the criteria for the Medal.

Nominations must include the candidate's <u>curriculum vitae</u>* and a <u>cover letter</u>* (cover letter must be written by nominee).

It is strongly recommended that the candidate's co-curricular record be attached to the nomination
