To whom it may concern,

The start of Concordia University's winter 2021 term will be delayed by one week. **Winter 2021 classes will now commence on Wednesday, January 13, 2021.** The term will remain a 13-week term, **ending on April 20, 2021.**

Please note the following additional details and date changes:

- The university will re-open on January 11 and all services will resume, including limited in-person access to the library and the Birks Student Service Centre.
- DNE date for winter 2021: moved from January 19 to **January 26**
- DISC for winter 2021: moved from March 22 to **March 29**
- The current dates for Reading Week 2021 (**March 1-5**) remain the same
- The new final exams period: **April 24 - May 9**
- Tuition fee deadlines have already been extended:

- The start of the 2021 summer terms will be delayed. More details on specific new dates will be available soon.
