### Diversity & Inclusion | 100%

- Established a code of conduct
- Encouraged participants to introduce themselves using their pronouns
- Used multiple channels for promotion at Concordia

### Accessibility | 100%

- Enabled participants to flag their accessibility needs
- Made the event free for all
- Encouraged participants to take breaks as needed.

## Indigenization | 100%

- Followed Concordia's Indigenous Elder and Community Protocols to offer proper compensation for participation
- Adapted Concordia's territorial acknowledgement and practiced pronunciation beforehand

## Waste & Transportation | 86%

- Prioritized digital event promotions
- Used reusable dishware
- Ensured proper waste bin options and waste sorting signage
- Arranged to have leftover food donated

## Purchasing & Sponsorship | 100%

- Chose a caterer that was local and committed to social sustainability
- Ensured at least half of the catering options were entirely plant-based
- Correctly labeled local, sustainable and culturally inclusive food and beverage

## Digital Consumption | 100%

- Chose a video platform with low carbon impact
- Invited participants to turn off their cameras
- Recorded event material and hosted on cloud-based sharing platform
