

The project **STANDBY** was created at the beginning of the academic year 2016/2017 to give visibility to the state of wait and uncertainty that the cuts in education of last years have provoked in the university community. The group there is had reinvent academician and professionally and also our vital path has seen affected. For it, we initiate artistic actions in between is "102 ideas and 60 months in STANDBY. Artistic project of educational mobilization", in that 102 persons have taken part between professorship, students and staff of University Jaume I. This collective piece, it recreates symbolically across a funnel and different objects the particular idea of the "university funnel". Every photography shows the personal vision of the university cuts, across visual metaphors in a photographic mural composed by 6 canvas of 1,26 x 3 meters of length. With it, we want to show the consequences that we consider, since it might not be differently, they influence the commonness of the persons. The sample commemorates five years of cuts that are fulfilled in these dates, in addition he it supposes an opportunity to demonstrate together the same experience from the different groups.






