Submissions

The *Concordia Undergraduate Journal of Art History* annually publishes 10-15 papers that best represent the talents of undergraduate students from the Faculty of Fine Arts. All students who have taken classes in the Faculty of Fine Arts and have received a grade of A or A+ on their paper are eligible to apply, so long as they have not graduated more than a nine months before the deadline for submission.

The *CUJAH Conference* allows for submissions of papers relating the conference theme from any program in any university. There is no minimum grade required for the papers submitted, however all submissions will be assessed based on their pertinence, originality, and contribution to scholarly knowledge. Presentations should last approximately 15 minutes.

Please be sure to read our [submission guidelines](#) carefully, as failure to follow these guidelines may result in the disqualification of your submission.
