3. Transcripts of post-secondary study. Note: All transcripts currently in student files are acceptable.
4. Names and contact information of three (3) referees, one of whom must be from Concordia University.
5. Examples of current work, as follows:
IMAGES: 8 to 12 images in JPEG format, minimum 72 dpi resolution, under 1 MB in size each. Include a separate document identifying and describing each image.
VIDEO: Up to two five-minute clips, saved at DV resolution (720 x 480) as Quicktime H.264 or Windows Media 8 or 9 files. Include a separate document identifying and describing each video clip. Additional material above and beyond that listed above will not be examined.
6. Proof of Canadian citizenship or landed residency.
8. Medical certificate indicating the duration of maternity or medical leave, if applicable.
