

# DIRECTOR'S NOTE

"My vision for The Birds is to build an ensemble piece that stays curious. Yvette Nolan's adaptation invites us to look at this old comedy through an Indigenous lens. I am not speaking from that perspective, but I want us to take it seriously and consider what it reveals about power, community, and the dream of a perfect place.

We are not creating ceremony. That is not ours to touch. What we are doing is approaching the story with integrity. We talk openly about representation, about what we do not know, and about how to carry this material with respect while still keeping the room playful.

The students have been learning a lot, sometimes without meaning to. They have discovered that comedy is never "easy." They have learned how to ask better questions, how to listen, and how to sit with the complicated parts instead of running from them. There has also been a healthy amount of chaos, which I choose to see as creative energy.

The themes in this play feel familiar today.

People chasing an easy world, a perfect
world, a world that never existed. Many
Indigenous communities know what happens
when those dreams are built on someone
else's land. So we laugh at the absurdity and
stay awake to the truth beneath it.

This ensemble is generous, hardworking, funny, and full of heart. They make the work worth it. If the play sparks conversation for you the way it has for us, then we have done something right.
