### DIRECTOR'S NOTE

"Let us go then, you and I, When the evening is spread out against the sky Like a patient etherized upon a table"

Within these first memorable lines of T. S, Eliot's "The Love Song of J. Alfred Prufrock", we are painted a portrait of beginnings and endings, of action and paralysis, of communion and solitude, all in one single phrase. "Indeed there will be time", we are promised, at the top of the 4th stanza: a stop-clock punched for 15 stanzas later when, "after tea and cakes and ices", there is decidedly no more time...

This performance is a rumination on this poem, but widely dilated. As a class, we sat down with "Prufrock" and discussed its many themes and imagery. We exchanged stories, wrote texts, improvised through movement and speech and acrobatics! What you will see on stage is not only a rumination on these themes as we imagine the poet intended, but our own versions of those themes, as well. They say "everyone in your dream is you" and here, in this resulting fever dream of a piece, are 20 individual Prufrocks, each with their own story, touch and texture.

Some of the texts you will hear tonight were written by the students themselves. Some are my own personal stories. And of course you will hear the very lines of *Prufrock*, at times diced and scattered, at times in their pure poetic form.

This project was a collaboration with Montreal's National Circus School. I can't tell you what joy it brings me to connect these two worlds: my lifelong passion of circus and my original passion of theatre. I am grateful to the direction of these two institutions for supporting this collaboration; grateful to the ENC students who squeezed this into their intense training schedules; grateful to the Concordia students for their generosity and curiosity embracing this new form.

"Oh, do not ask, 'What is it?'
