WHEN AND WHERE

Project posters will be presented at the Palais des congrès from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. in the exhibition hall.

To participate in the contest, you must prepare:

- A poster written in French or in English, in a vertical format, measuring 90 cm by 135 cm, mounted on Foamcore
- An interactive oral presentation, 180 seconds long at most
- Physical supporting material: simulation, demo, etc. (optional).

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The jury will base its evaluations on the following three criteria:

- The project's innovation and scope
- The precision of the objectives proposed and the expected results
- The clarity of the poster and provided explanation.

Particular attention will be paid to the quality of the scientific communication to a lay audience. The poster must be accessible.

A simple and direct style is suggested.

PRIZES

- Prizes: Two passes for MSI 2016, worth a total of \$250 (student rate)
- Winners will be invited to present their projects to all of the participants during the Summit.
- The best poster recipient team will be invited for an on-stage appearance during the programming of the MSI in 2016.
