

# Mature Entry Program (MEP) for BCompSc students

Canadians and Permanent Residents who are 21 years of age or older and lack the normal pre-university schooling, may be considered for admission to the MEP, which requires successful completion of a minimum of 18 additional credits.

**Here are the MEP requirements based on your program:**

## ***Bachelor of Computer Science (18 credits):***

- MATH 203, MATH 204, and MATH 205 (9 credits)
- 6 elective credits chosen from courses in [Humanities](#) or [Social Sciences](#) as noted in [Section 71.110 Complementary Studies for Engineering and Computer Science Students](#)
- 3 elective credits may be chosen as follows:
  - [General Education Electives](#) found in Complementary Studies for Engineering and Computer Science Students.
  - [Engineering and Natural Science Group: Software Engineering](#)

- ❖ English as a Second Language (ESL) Courses and courses that focus on the acquisition of a language may **not** be used to meet MEP requirements.
