

### Registration Process

ENGR 411 is a one-credit course consisting of an unsupervised Technical Report. It is intended for students who are short one credit or less from meeting graduation requirements. To apply, please complete this form and email it to [mie-upa@encs.concordia.ca](mailto:mie-upa@encs.concordia.ca).

Once approved, you will be registered and receive a signed copy of the form to bind with your final report.

### Course Requirements

The ENGR 411 report is a **critical literature survey** on a technical topic of your choice, relevant to your program of study. The topic must be **specific, focused, and technical in nature**.

Your report must be **original** and may **not include material previously submitted for other coursework**.

The report will be graded based on technical content as well as format and presentation as follows:
