A graduate of Concordia University with a Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Sylvain is a recognized expert in water safety and security and he advises several companies and Canadian municipalities on Cross-Connection Engineering. As a certified AWWA trainer, he has trained hundreds of backflow device testers

across Quebec. From 2009 to 2015, he worked as the Certification Officer and Technical Consultant for the AWWA Quebec Section. He also served as the section representative to the AWWA Canadian Coordinating Cross-Connections Control Committee where he is still acting as a consultant. In June 2015, Sylvain was recognized by the industry and he was awarded the AWWA's prestigious George Warren Fuller Prize. Since October 2015, Sylvain is a member of the AWWA Cross Connection Control committee.
