STATE-OF-THE-ART FACILITIES

The school's state-of-the-art facilities are housed in the John Molson School of Business Building, the dynamic green centre of Concordia's downtown campus. This architecturally stunning 37,000-squaremetre 15-storey landmark boasts a distinctive design that incorporates bright atriums, modern classrooms, networking spaces, a 300-seat auditorium, six amphitheatres and two basement levels that link it to neighbouring buildings and to the metro system.

In 2012, the building was granted Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Silver certification status by the Canada Green Building Council (CaGBC), officially recognizing Concordia's longstanding commitment to sustainable practices.




ABOUT OUR STUDENTS

GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (GDBA)

PRIMARY FUNCTIONAL AREAS OF ORGANIZATIONS AND THEIR INTERRELATIONS

The Graduate Diploma in Business Administration is designed for people looking for a foundation in business fundamentals to become more efficient and effective managers and administrators. At the end of the program, not only will students have a good understanding of the functional areas within an organization, but they will also appreciate how those areas inter-relate. This program prepares students from various backgrounds to confidently advance in their careers, and is available to both Canadian and international students.

The diploma is a 30-credit (10 courses of 3 credits each) program that can be completed on a part-time or full-time basis with a flexible schedule offering daytime and evening classes, as well as some weekend and online options. Diploma students must enrol in nine core and one special topic courses to complete the program.

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (GCBA)

CORE ELEMENTS OF ORGANIZATIONS

The Graduate Certificate in Business Administration is designed for candidates seeking a short and focused graduate-level business program that introduces them to key business concepts. At the end of the certificate, students will have a solid understanding of the functional areas within an organization. The GCBA is not open to international students.

The 15-credit (5 courses of 3 credits each) certificate program can be completed on a parttime or full-time basis with a flexible schedule offering daytime and evening classes, as well as some weekend options. Certificate students must enrol in five core courses to complete the program.



ADMISSION CRITERIA

- An undergraduate degree* in any field from a recognized university, with a minimum GPA of 2.7/4.3 or B- (70%) average
 - Submission of:
 - A statement of purpose explaining why you want to pursue a GDBA or GCBA (approximately 500 words)
 - Two detailed letters of reference*. These can be from employers, university instructors or volunteer organizations and should speak to your ability to succeed in the program
 - A current résumé (curriculum vitae)
 - Students whose primary language is not English must write a pre-admission proficiency test (TOEFL iBT minimum score 90 or IELTS minimum score 7.0), if not exempted as indicated below.
 - Exemptions:
 - Quebec applicants who have completed a Diploma of Collegial Studies (DEC) and a university degree in Quebec
 - A minimum of three full years of study either at the undergraduate or graduate level in an institution where the sole language of instruction is English

*Original academic transcripts and letters of reference must be received in hard copies in sealed envelopes from the issuing institution and referees.
