PhD Fellowship

The National Bank Initiative in Entrepreneurship and Family Business is funded by a generous endowment from National Bank. This fellowship is intended to attract and retain a deserving PhD student with an interest in entrepreneurship and/or family business.

Who Can Apply

Full-time PhD students who have been admitted to or are currently registered in the PhD in Business Administration program at JMSB.

Value

The fellowship is valued at **\$20,000**.

Duration

The duration of this award is for one year and is renewable up to three times as long as the student maintains the required progress, academic standing, and is scheduled to graduate within their program's normal completion time.

Application Deadline Date

Please submit one complete hard copy to MB 11.335 by April 30, 2015 at 12:00 noon. Applications must include all the required documents. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Required Documents

- 1. Unofficial transcripts of all university studies (bachelor, master, doctoral);
- 2. An up to date curriculum vitae (CV);
- 3. A list of all publications and relevant professional and research experience;
- 4. A research proposal (max. 1,200 words) explaining (a) your interest in Entrepreneurship and/or Family Business, and (b) describing your research objectives for your PhD thesis (what is the research question/problem you are interested in, why is this relevant/important, how does it contribute to the existing literature on the topic);
- 5. One letter of recommendation from your supervisor or a faculty member who has taught you.

Adjudication

Adjudication is done by the Scientific Committee of the National Bank Initiative in Entrepreneurship and Family Business.
