This Curriculum Collection is designed to support student teachers in the Early Childhood and Elementary Education (ECEE) programme. It contains a selection of practice teaching materials for preschool and elementary school age children. The collection includes children's books (fiction & non-fiction), activity and lesson planning books as well as a few sample games and puzzles.

This QR code will bring you directly to an online guide on the library site where you can browse some **examples** of titles useful for early childhood education such as:

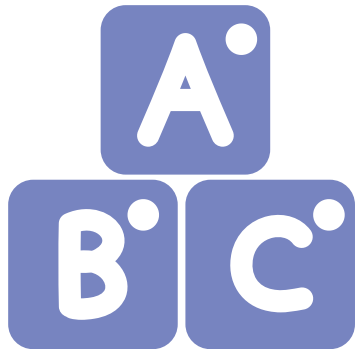
- children's books by themes

The collection is organized by Library of Congress classification. It is a way for us to categorize and shelve books. Call numbers provide the physical location of the book, while call number ranges will reflect a certain subject area.

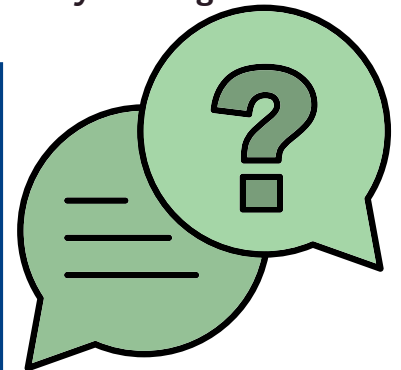
