RefWorks is a Web-based tool that allows you to:

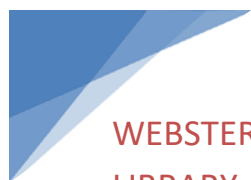
1. Manage and organize the bibliographic references you find in library catalogues and databases

Institutional Repository

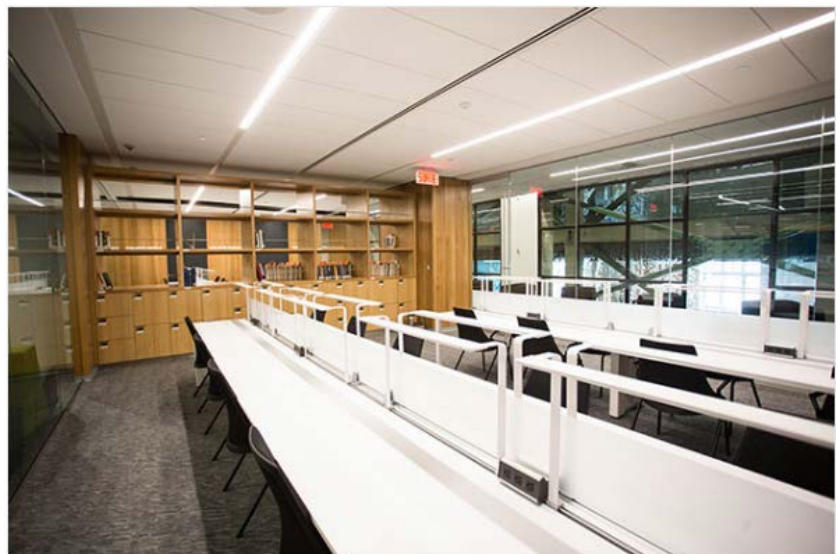
