USING GOOGLE SCHOLAR

ARE THE ARTICLES REALLY PEER-REVIEWED?

HOW ARE GOOGLE SCHOLAR AND A DATABASE DIFFERENT?

Library Databases

- Provide the ability to focus search by subject area.
- Allow users to sort results according to date and relevance.
- Allow users to sort results by type of material (academic journal, magazine, newspaper, etc).
- Contain the ability to limit searches by a variety of criteria
- Will never charge you for the full text of an article if the Library has a subscription to that database.

Google Scholar

- Does not have the ability to focus search by subject area.
- Does not have an easy way to sort articles in your results list.
- Does not clearly specify what type of material (academic journal, magazine, newspaper, etc) is in the results list.
- Does not have full criteria to limit your search results.
- Provides full text of some electronic articles, but is not as helpful in tracking down print articles. Some articles may be available for a fee.


