Checking the open access and peer review status of journal articles

1. Search the journal article databases (above) for articles on your topic, using keywords.



2. Choose articles that are relevant to your topic.



3. Identify the journal titles, from the articles you have selected, it will be the second title in a citation, often referred to as a 'Source' in some library databases:

If the journal is open access and listed in the DOAJ, it can be used in your research paper.

If you cannot locate the title of an open access journal in the DOAJ, it <u>cannot</u> be used in your research paper.
