The 5W and 1 H

What is your general topic?
Who does it concern? What population do you want to research?
What? What is the object, the core of your research?
When? What time period is of interest for you and your question?
Where? What geographical do you want to study?
Why? What is your interest?
How? What interaction are you investigating?

Example:

General topic: Women and Islam

Who? Adult women

What? How women clothing is being policed through religion

When? In the last decade

Where? France

Why? I want to find reasonings and legal impacts.

How? How is clothing being policed?
