CHOOSING A RESEARCH TOPIC

It's a process

• Choosing a research topic is research.

• The process is iterative, not linear.

Technique to narrow your research topic: The 5 W and 1 H



Example

General topic: Women, islam, clothing

What? Women's clothing policing

Who? Adult women

When? 21st century

Where? France

Why? Political motivation

How? Legal aspects

Research question
