What is citation for?

- Showing the work put into research
- Giving credit for ideas and respecting copyright
- Allowing others to replicate findings and check accuracy of conclusions
- Helping other researchers find interesting resources
- Situating the author's voice in the scholarly conversation

How, when, and where to cite

HOW

- Use only one citation style for each project
- Identify types of sources before you cite

WHEN

- Direct quotes (exact words between quotation marks)
- Paraphrasing (ideas and facts from a source, in your own words)
- Information or facts that are not common knowledge
 - ex. the Eiffel tower is in Paris vs. the Eiffel tower receives 7 million visitors per year

WHERE

- In-text citation at the end of the sentence
- End-of-text citation in a list of sources

Introduction

This guide provides some basic examples of the Chicago citation style. It is based on the 17th edition of the Chicago Manual of Style published in 2017. Copies of the full manual are available at the Vanier and Webster Libraries' Reference Desks and Reference Collections, as well as online. The call number for the manual is Z 253 U69 2010.

The Chicago Manual of Style has two basic systems for documentation of sources: (1) **notes and bibliography** and (2) **author-date**.

Notes and bibliography (N & B)

This system is used primarily by those writing in the humanities (literature, history, classics etc.) Sources are cited in numbered footnotes or endnotes. Each **note** corresponds to a superscript number within the text. Additionally, sources are listed in a separate **bibliography**. This system is able to accommodate a wider variety of sources than can the author-date system.

Works cited - Examples

- Book with a single author or editor
- Book with multiple authors
- Chapter in a multi-author book
- E-book (from the library catalogue)
- Book review
- Article in a print journal



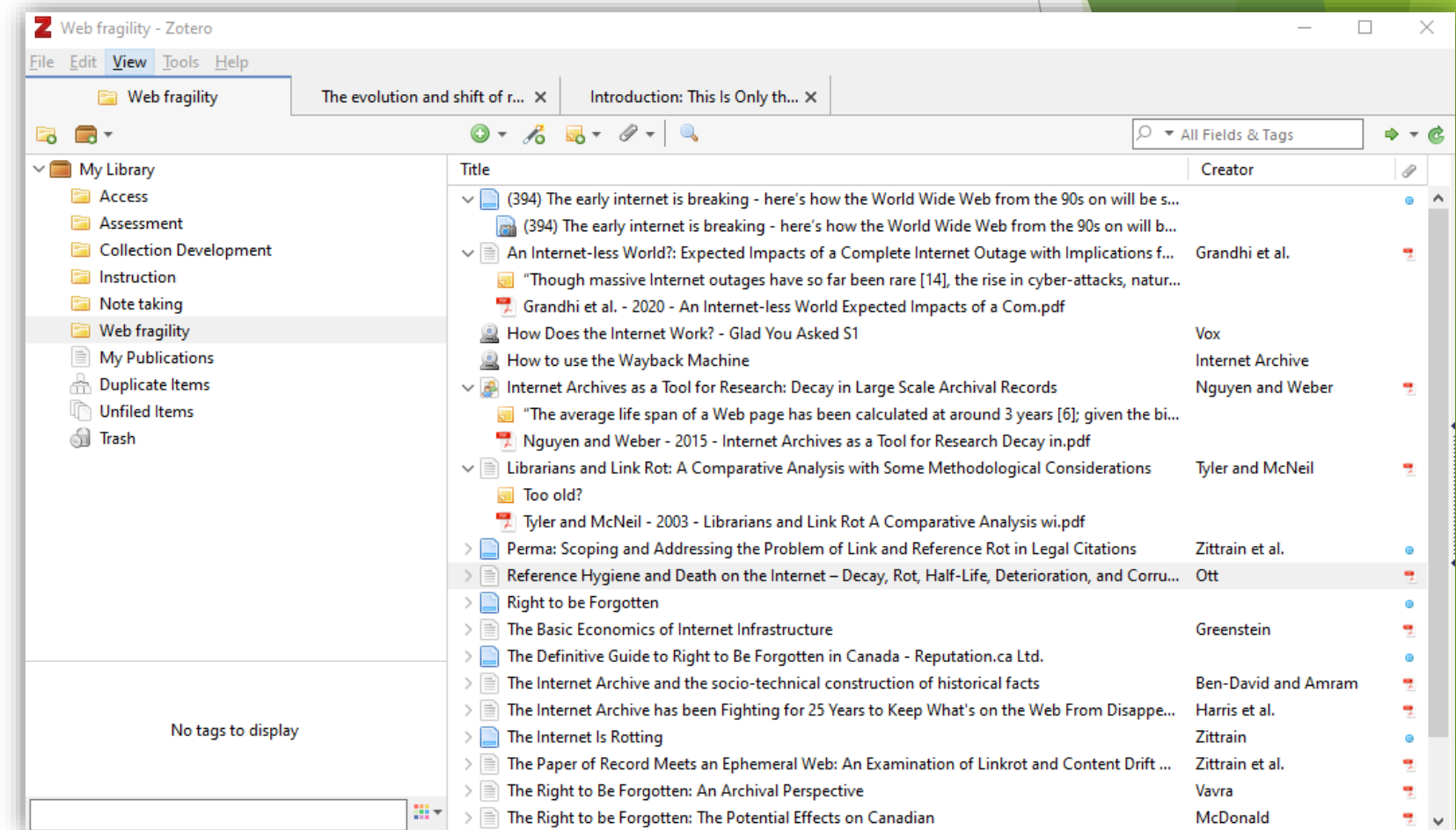
