





Topics & Keywords

Choosing the most relevant topics and keywords will help you search most research tools efficiently.

Example A

Research question/topic:

Representations of Auschwitz in movies

Search question:

(Auschwitz OR Holocaust OR Shoah) AND (movie* OR film* OR motion pictures)

Example B

Research question/topic:

Christian women in movies


Search question:

Christian* AND wom* AND (movie* OR video* OR film* OR motion picture*)




Search operators

 AND limits your search, both words must be present in the book or article result religion AND postmodernism



 OR broadens your search, either of the words must be present in the book or article result expiation OR atonement



- A "phrase search" (using "") limits, only the exact phrase will be present in the book or article result "belief system"
- Truncation (*)broadens your search, many variations
 on the same word will be located
 relig* finds: religion, religions, religious, religiosity, religare

ATLA Religion Database with ATLA Serials



The American Theological Library Association's ATLAS Religion Database (ATLA + Serials fulltext) is a partially fulltext database that covers such topics as Biblical studies, world religions, Church history, and religious perspectives on social issues. It includes articles from journals, essays from multi-author works, and book reviews. Corresponds to Religion Index One: Periodicals, Religion Index Two: Multi-author Works and Index to Book Reviews in Religion. The Catholic Periodical and Literature Index (CPLI) is also part of ATLAS. Coverage: 1949 onward updated semi-annually Documents indexed: Books, Essays, Journal Articles. 
New Testament abstracts



Includes indexing and abstracts for journal articles, monographs, multi-authored books, book reviews, and biblical software programs. All abstracts are in English, regardless of the language of the original work. It is possible to search by specific scripture passages. Coverage: 1985 onward Documents indexed: Book Reviews, Books, Essays, Journal Articles, Magazine Articles



Moving Image Collection



The VCR Moving Image Collection is comprised of over 41,000 titles dating from 1895 to the current year. As such, it reflects the historical introduction of new technologies for teaching and learning since 1988, retaining the older media formats as well as including later editions. The online catalogue provides access to over 21,000 titles on DVD, 3,100 on Blu-ray disc (including 3D and UHD 4K), as well as 4500 VHS tapes and 1200 laserdiscs.

In addition, VCR holds the Moving Image Collection's 11,500 historically significant archival 16mm and 35mm films, which range from experimental, to instructional and industrial documentary films, and to world cinema. The highlights include the National Film Board of Canada's lending library until 1990, the British Information Services collection of travelogues and documentaries from the 1960s and 1970s, the Shastri Collection of Indian documentary films, and a growing collection of student films from Concordia's Mel Hoppenheim School of Cinema.
