Different types of academic literature

- Reference sources (dictionaries, encyclopedia)
- Books (in-depth overview of a topic)
 - Many academic books are published by university presses (e.g. McGill-Queen's University Press, Les Presses de l'Université de Montréal).
- Articles (scholarly, peer-reviewed or referred)
- Systematic reviews
- Theses
- Conference papers
- Expert reports (e.g. reports initiated at a government's request)

Is this article peer-reviewed?

- Select "Scholarly or peer-reviewed" as a limiter (or facet) in most databases and discovery tools.
- Look at journal websites, sections "About us" and the editorial statements. There should be a mention of the peer-reviewed process.
- Use <u>Ulrich's Periodical Directory</u>. You can look up a journal title in this directory to verify if it is peer-reviewed.



Searching for commentaries – Sofia Discovery tool


