



Program/Institutional Review

- 1 Application is reviewed to ensure it meets with the agency guidelines and program description.
- 2 Allows time for the researcher to receive feedback and make any necessary revisions.
- 3 Institutional review is completed to ensure additional commitments if any are in place.
- 4 Approval by university authorized signatories
- 5 Due to remote working, time required for response (due to increased meeting load) and system failures.

The Benefits of Internal Grant Review

- 1 Ensures the application is not rejected or refused due to missed requirements. Internal review improves the quality of grant submissions and hence, enhances the likelihood of funding in a peer-reviewed grant competition.
- 2 Both new and experienced investigators benefit from the process of prior review of their grant application by a new set of eyes.
- 3 OOR staff have insights from various agency program officers on what the agency is looking for and expecting from applicants.
