The Incremental Project grants (IPG) funding opportunity is a stream of the Research Support Fund (RSF) that provides further support for the indirect costs of research, in addition to the RSF grant. The IPG provides additional support for projects in the following four priority areas:

- Innovation and commercialization activities;
- Facilities renewal, including deferred maintenance;
- Information resources, including digital resources, open access and databases;
- Equity, diversity and faculty renewal (in the context of equity, diversity and inclusion); and
- Research security
