Ms Beaudoin provided Council members with a brief overview of the SGS Highlights document. In response to a question from a Council member about interdisciplinary programs, Ms Beaudoin replied that significant work in this area had been undertaken by the Academic Programs unit under former Associate Dean, Vivek Venkatesh and Ms. Frédérica Martin; Dr Nelson has taken on this portfolio for 2015-2016 and several new projects are on the horizon.

Dr Caminati explained that the Awards unit had been working steadily on the formula allocation and expects the details to be distributed in December, as planned. Dr Nelson noted that a draft strategic plan for the School of Graduate Studies aligned with the Strategic Directions exercise is currently in progress and should be made available to members by the end of the year.

A Council member suggested that more efforts be made in securing teaching opportunities for graduate students, in particular for those in INDI and the PhD in Humanities. Dr Nelson agreed that this represents a challenge, and pointed out that the School is mindful of the situation and advocates on behalf of these programs whenever possible while respecting the roles of the Deans in the Faculties.
