Dr Venkatesh welcomed Vice-President Christophe Guy to the first meeting of the Council of the School of Graduate Studies who then addressed members. Since Dr Guy's appointment a few short months ago, he has been on the ground meeting faculty members, staff and students. He has toured each of the faculties and research centres, and has discovered a vibrant community who highly values research and graduate studies. Dr Guy reiterated his pleasure in occupying the position of Vice-President not only of Research but also of Graduate Studies – a relatively unique portfolio across Canada.

Dr Guy shared his view of our role as a public institution and our obligation to translate our discoveries to society. He acknowledged that one of the best ways to do so is through our graduates who leave us to work in industry, non-profits, etc. He pledged his support for graduate studies and to ongoing research development during his tenure as Vice-President.

New Program: Microprogramme en didactique et linguistique pour l'enseignement du français (FRAN-30)

Dr Nelson reminded Council members that the CSGS had previously delegated authority to approve curriculum changes other than new programs to the Graduate Curriculum Committee (GCC). Curriculum changes approved by GCC would be reported to Council in a summary, as in document D8 of the present package. Members were free to discuss any of the dossiers mentioned in the GCC Report.

Dr Nelson provided an overview of the new *microprogramme* and stated that it does not lead to teacher certification. Its purpose is to provide enrichment to teachers already in the field and to respond to the immediate needs in the teaching of French, as they are

identified. There are no new course allotments required as they are drawn from the department's existing allocation.
