Short Bio

Philomène Longpré is an artist whose research encompasses robotic art, interactive video, and performance. Since 1999, she is dedicated to the development of responsive art systems that translate body language while exploring the interaction between the physical and virtual world.

She holds a Ph.D. degree from Concordia University in the study and practice of the arts. Her dissertation “Video Screen as Matrix of Sensations: A Multisensory Approach to the Artistic Development of Responsive Video Membranes” investigates multisensory manifestations in interactive video installations and proposes a transdisciplinary inquiry into the artistic development of responsive video membranes. Her research involved ethnographic investigations of how video displays materiality, spatiality, and interactivity as key factors in altering perception, and how these factors augment sensory, affective, and cognitive responses to a moving image. An essential aspect of her artistic approach involves a unique collaboration among the fields of fine arts, anthropology of the senses, computer science, and mechanical engineering. Longpré also completed an M.F.A. in Art and Technology Studies from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, as well as an B.F.A. in Studio Arts from Concordia University.

Longpre’s works have been presented in numerous solo and group exhibitions around the world. Recent exhibitions include *Cereus Queen of the Night*, at the PHI Center during Elektra International Digital Arts Festival and *Formica*, at the C-2 Mtl and at the BIAN International Digital Arts Biennial in Canada ; *Illusio*, at the EXIT and VIA Festivals in France; *Telematic Exchange*, at the Looptopia Festival and at Collider Festival in United States; *Octopus*, at FILE Electronic Art Festival in Brazil and AIR Hong Kong Arts Centre in Hong Kong ; and *Passage*, at BUDI in South Korea, Thailand New Media Art Festival and at the Festival Di Cupramontana in Italy.

As a faculty member of the Department of Art and Technology Studies at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago, she taught Robotic Arts, Mechatronics, Wired (an introduction to media arts and innovative digital imaging), and Contemporary Practice in Art and Technology. Furthermore, she also taught Interactive Video Systems at the Hong Kong Art School and Experimental Cinema, (theory and practice on experimental film and video performance) at DXARTS Center, University of Washington. Currently, she is leading collaborative research in art and technology at her robotic art lab in Montreal and create a new interactive installation for the Grand Théâtre de Québec.
